Dear student,

United Veterinary Service will once again be offering a \$1,000.00 scholarship to a graduating high school senior this spring. Half of the scholarship, \$ 500.00, is paid for the first year of college or technical school, and the second half, \$500.00, is paid for the second year of studies. The scholarship application is available to any student in our practice area who was enrolled in a supervised animal project in 4-H, FFA or Scouting. There are no restrictions regarding the area of study the student pursues.

The application includes a list of the projects the student was engaged in and a short essay about the life lessons learned with the project. The deadline for the completed application is March 31, 2024.
