Dear student,

United Veterinary Service will once again be offering a \$1,000.00 scholarship to a graduating high school senior this spring. Half of the scholarship, \$ 500.00, is paid for the first year of college or technical school, and the second half, \$500.00, is paid for the second year of studies. The scholarship application is available to any student within our practice area who was enrolled in a supervised animal project in 4-H, FFA or Scouting. There are no restrictions regarding the area of study the student pursues.

The application includes a list of the projects the student was engaged in and a short essay about the life lessons learned with the project. The deadline for the completed application is March 31, 2026.

Attached is a general scholarship application. If your school has a general form that is similar, and gathers the same general information, please feel free to use it. The last page, however, is specific to our scholarship and needs to be used.
